Dear Contractor:

The Yakama Nation's Upper Columbia Habitat Restoration Project (UHRP) is requesting bids for construction of the Foghorn Reach Restoration Project – Phase 1. This project is to be implemented along the Methow River from approximately rivermile 51, upstream to approximately rivermile 52, just north of Winthrop town.

A pre-bid site tour for this project will be held on **Wednesday April 22, 2026**, starting at **1:00 PM**. The site visit will be conducted by Yakama Nation Fisheries Habitat Specialist Ben Woodworth and Rio ASE Professional Engineer Tim Sickles.

- The site tour will begin at the Douglas PUD Methow Fish Hatchery (**44C Wolf Creek Road, Winthrop, WA**) and will continue to a private landowner's property (**3 Merganser Lane, Winthrop, WA**).
- The site visit is anticipated to be attended by Douglas PUD Hatchery Manager Thomas Kohl and private landowners Jessica and Joe Klein.
- We will start the tour at the hatchery address and caravan across the river to the private landowner's property afterward.

**Driving directions to Site Tour:** From the IGA Thriftway in Winthrop, drive north along Highway 20. Take a left onto **Twin Lakes Road** and drive for approximately 1.5 miles. Take a right onto **Wolf Creek Road** and drive for approximately 0.5 miles. Take a right at the **Douglas PUD Hatchery** and continue down the driveway until you reach the facility. Park at the hatchery facility.

From the hatchery facility, back track to Highway 20 and take a left. Continue on Highway 20 through Winthrop town and take a left at the 4-way stop headed towards Mazama. Drive for approximately 0.5 miles and turn left onto the driveway leading to **3 Merganser Lane**.

By close of business on **Wednesday, May 6, 2026** each contractor that wishes to be considered must have completed and submitted a signed copy of the Foghorn Reach Restoration Project - Phase 1 Bid Sheet along with supporting documentation. Please specify in writing on the bid sheet that prices will be valid for at least 180 days. All competitive bid materials must be delivered by parcel delivery service or postal mail to:

We recommend getting completed bids in the mail by **May 1, 2024**, to ensure delivery on time. We also recommend that you email **Annet Dillman** (dila@yakamafish-nsn.gov) and **Ben Woodworth** (woob@yakamafish-nsn.gov) a digital copy of your final bid documents as well as a copy of your certified mail certificate for proof of submission. Make sure the certified mail certificate clearly lists the name and address of the sender and recipient.

Major portions of this project will be conducted between **July 1, 2026 and July 31, 2026**, to coincide with the permitted in-water work windows negotiated with NOAA, USFWS, and WDFW. **Additional considerations on scheduling include the disruption of hatchery operations for work performed in the South Work Area, with the preferred timeline for these actions to take place in the latter half of July.** The winning contractor will understand the magnitude of this project and be equipped to perform all necessary elements for a project of this type within designated timelines.

All contractors submitting bids for this project shall provide and/or demonstrate, at a minimum, the following:

- **A signed and fully completed bid sheet**
- **A list of key pieces of heavy equipment that will be used in construction of the project.**
- **A list of experienced equipment operators that will be on-site during project construction. Please provide details of their work on in-stream habitat enhancement structures within the past several years.**
- **A brief narrative describing your strategy for completing this work including a detailed construction timeline.**

Please note:

- Davis Bacon Wages apply to this contract. The winning contractor will adhere to the Davis Bacon rules and comply and submit all necessary paperwork to the Yakama Nation.
- The winning contractor will have all equipment cleaned and inspected prior to entering the any portion of the project site.
- The Yakama Nation is exempt from state taxes on this project. Please see the attached Treaty Fishery Exempt Cover Letter and Treaty Fishery Exempt Certificate. The winning contractor will receive signed copies for their records.
- This project has adopted by reference in the Engineer's Planset the 2024 Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction. Please review the attached template Construction Services Agreement for the Scope of Work associated for this project. Please make note of specific provisions provided in this Construction Services Agreement, including the detailed Exhibits, that may be in addition to the specifications and direction found in the Project plan set.

**The following categories will be used to evaluate the competitiveness of bids received:**

- Demonstrated experience with this type of work – 15%
- Demonstrated quality of work – 15%
- Cost – 15%
- Schedule – 10%
- Company integrity/references – 10%
- Demonstrated experience with permitting agencies in the Upper Columbia Region – 10%
- Adequacy/quality of staff and equipment proposed – 15%
- Completeness of Proposal (Based on RFP Submission Requirements) – 10%

Also, please note that this project is pending on permitting. The Yakama Nation reserves the right to accept or reject any and all of the proposals received as a result of this request, or to cancel in part or entirely this request if it is in the best interest of the Yakama Nation to do so. This request does not commit the Yakama Nation to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of a proposal.
